FROM THE OFFICE OF THE COMMISSION PRESIDENT DECLARATION 2023-001

WHEREAS, the impending weather to hit the City of Hillsboro from April 3, 2023, to April 6, 2023, and

WHEREAS, the National Weather Service is predicting up to 24 inches of snow and a blizzard warning, and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department will be taxed to capacity for this amount of snowfall,

WHEREAS, the best way to prevent the loss of life and property is to be prepared for this potential issue.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Levi Reese, Commission President of the City of Hillsboro and working with City Superintendent Jim Anderson; proclaim that the City of Hillsboro declares a Snow Emergency to prepare for the potential winter storm. Effective immediately, this declaration enacts Ordinance 532, now listed under Section 9.1410, which prohibits parking on the streets within the City of Hillsboro until the street has been cleared of snow.

I ask that the city residents be prepared for the potential loss of power and access to infrastructure. Please stay safe, and if the city can help in any way please feel free to reach out to me, or if it is an emergency situation please call 911 for assistance.
