

ORDINANCE No. 522

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 8.06 OF TITLE 8 OF THE 2020 REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF HILLSBORO.

Be it ordained by the City Commission of the City of Hillsboro, State of North Dakota:

Chapter 8.06 of Title 8 of the 2020 Revised Ordinances of the City of Hillsboro is hereby amended to read as follows:

8.0639 Microbrew Pub License

1. A microbrew pub licensee may manufacture on the licensed premises, store, transport, sell, and export malt beverages on- and off-sale subject to the following restrictions and conditions:
 - a. Such license may be issued only to a person or entity holding a license from the state tax commissioner allowing for the production of malt beverages.
 - b. Any license issued hereunder will only authorize the licensee to sell beer produced on the premises by the licensee at on-sale.
 - c. Any license issued hereunder will only authorize the licensee to sell beer produced on the premises by the licensee at off sale in brewery sealed containers of not more than 3.0 gallons (11.36 liters).
 - d. A licensee may not sell to any person for off-premises consumption more than two hundred eighty-eight ounces (8.51 liters) of beer per day, in any size brewery-sealed container of not more than three gallons (11.36 liters)
 - e. Any licensee is authorized to sell and deliver beer produced by the licensee to licensed beer wholesalers.
 - f. Complimentary samples of malt beverages may be served on the premises in amounts not exceeding sixteen (16) ounces per patron.
 - g. Special events for which a permit has been obtained from state tax commissioner allowing the microbrew pub licensee to give free samples of its beer, to sell its beer by the glass or in enclosed containers, or to dispense beer manufactured by licensee at a designated trade show, convention, festival, fundraiser, or other related special event hosted by a nonprofit organization unaffiliated with the license, or a similar event approved by the tax commissioner, at off-premises events require an event permit under Section 8.0638 issued by the City Commission.
 - h. Any licensee shall produce no more than ten thousand (10,000) barrels of malt beverages annually.
 - i. Any licensee may transfer beer in bulk manufactured by the licensee to an affiliated microbrew pub licensee.
 - j. Any license may operate a restaurant contiguous to the brewery when granted an on-sale license for retailing alcohol beverages.
