Did you know?

- ❖ Licenses may be purchased for the amount of time that a rabies vaccination is valid for.
- ❖ A license term cannot exceed the rabies vaccination expiration date. A 1-year license purchased during a 3-year rabies vaccination period will expire on the anniversary (i.e. the same day and month) of the license date.
- ❖ If a tag is lost, please enclose \$20 for a replacement tag.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

All dogs over 6 months of age are required to be vaccinated against rabies and licensed. Failure to license may result in a citation and/or fine.
